This free cataract eye surgery was followed by Malang residents of many areas particularly Jatimulyo, Sumber Sari, Penanggungan and Sumbersekar after they passed screening in the initial stage.

Around 71 residents out of 144 registrants who have passed the screening, finally could join in cataract eye surgery with free-of-charge. The social charity activity could not go away from the roles of IKA UB (Ikatan Alumni Universitas Brawijaya/Brawijaya University Alumni Bonding) in collaboration with Persatuan Dokter Mata Indonesia (PERDAMI/Indonesian Ophthalmologist Union).
