The two sides signed a memorandum of cooperation to deepen the exchanges and cooperation between the clinical services, teaching and research of bilateral medical personnel, and open the international medical care of the hospital. The Indonesian delegation was warmly welcomed by the medical staff of the National Taiwan University Yunlin Branch. The two sides signed a memorandum of cooperation to start the kinetic energy of medical exchange between Taiwan and Indonesia.

Huang Ruiren, Dean of the University of Taiwan's Yunlin Branch, said that the Weifu Department initiated the policy of “New South-to-Southern Medical Cooperation and Industry Chain, One Country, One Centre” this year. Indonesia is responsible for the project. The institute cooperates with the system to work on East Java, including the first.
